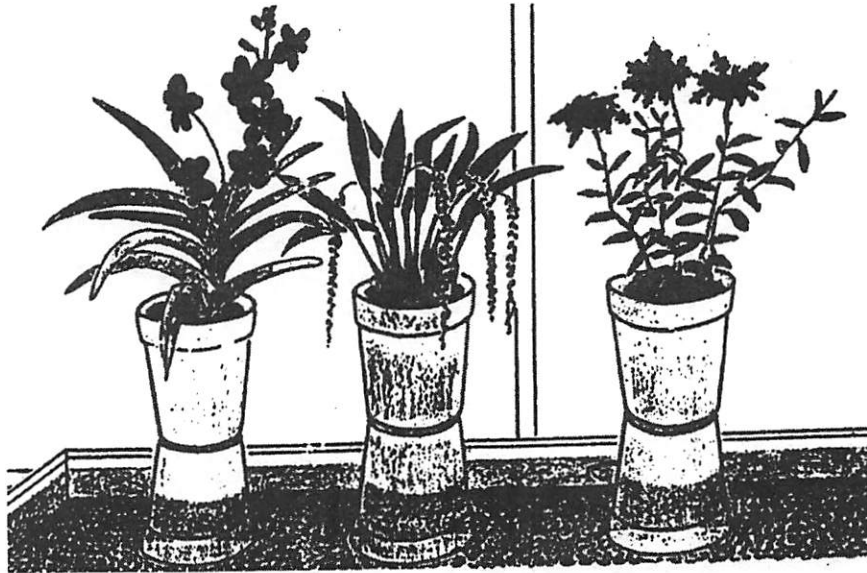




**"KEEPING ORCHIDS WELL IN DRY AIR CONDITIONS"
How to set up an easy humidity tray.**



In order to increase humidity, flowerpots turned upside down in a water-filled container are used as a platform for orchids.

1. Obtain a container at least two inches deep and wider than the leaves of orchid plant. A plastic plant tray works well for this.
2. You'll need aquarium gravel, in your choice of color, sufficient to layer the bottom of the container and mound-up to keep the plant above the water level. A dish or another pot also works well.
3. Add water and place orchid plant atop of the gravel mound or dish.

For larger collections, a big tray container with a grid directly on top does well or a number of smaller containers set among your plants will accomplish the same humidifying results.

Note: You still need to water the plant(s) at least once a week..
