

<u>Cultural Requirements – Coelogyne</u>

Pronounced: see-LODGE-eh-nee Tribe: Coelogyneae | Subtribe: Coelogyninae

Known for its pseudobulbs with one or two leaves, varying in size and shape. With over 200 species found throughout Southeast Asia in tropical rainforests, with some growing in open, humid environments.

Temperature: Intermediate with a few preferring warmth and some preferring slightly cooler temperatures.

Lighting: 800-1800 footcandles (similar to Phalaenopsis and Oncidiums)



Watering: Consistent moisture with good drainage being careful to avoid standing water in new growths.

Fertilizer: Balanced such as 20-20-20, $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp/gallon applied every other week.

Potting: Recommended to repot every 2 years or so.
