

## <u>Cultural Requirements – Dendrochilum</u>

Pronounced: den-dro-KYE-lum

**Tribe:** Coelogyneae | **Subtribe:** Coelogyninae

Founded in 1825 using a generic name reflecting their epiphytic nature and distinctive labellum. Most of the 313 species (as of 9/2007) in this genus are small plants that prolifically bloom and found growing throughout Southeast Asia, with main centers in Borneo, the Philippines, and Sumatra at elevations exceeding 1000 m.



**Temperature:** Warm to cool with good air circulation

**Lighting:** Bright, indirect light

**Watering:** Frequently, from the base, to keep plant moist. Should never be allowed to completely dry out. Maintain high humidity.

**Fertilizer:** Balanced such as 20-20-20, ½ tsp/gallon applied every other week.

**Potting:** Recommended to repot before new growths appear, typically in the spring.
