

## <u>Cultural Requirements – Paphinia</u>

Pronounced: pah-FINN-ee-ah

**Tribe:** Maxillarieae | **Subtribe:** Stanhopeinae

This tropical genus is known for its showy flowers. Most species are found in the Amazon, with Paphinia cristata being the most widespread. The flowers, which are colorful and range from 3" to 8" across, can be single or multi-flowered. As of 2020, 16 species and 6 varieties of Paphinia are recognized and predominantly distributed across Tropical America.



**Temperature:** Intermediate to warm, depending on species

**Lighting:** Low to intermediate.

**Watering:** Plants should NOT dry out completely. Thrive in high humidity with 70-90% preferred.

**Fertilizer:** Not heavy feeders. Balanced fertilizer at half strength weekly is sufficient.

**Potting:** Small pots or baskets with moisture-retaining medium. Mounted on soft treefern slabs beneficial given their pendent spikes.
